



# THE 2017 NMUN•NY VIDEO CONTEST

Show us why your organization had the best National Model United Nations (NMUN) experience and you could win a scholarship to help cover some of your expenses for next year's conference. All delegations attending NMUN•New York in 2017 are invited to record a short video documenting their team's conference preparation and participation, both at home and in New York. The video contest provides an opportunity to creatively showcase your organization's enthusiasm for NMUN as well as the richness of the conference experience.

## Requirements:

- Videos must be 2-5 minutes in length, including credits. Videos over 5 minutes will be disqualified.
- Videos should focus on NMUN•New York activities leading up to, during, and following the 2017 conference. They should include (but are not limited to) preparation for the conference, team meetings or activities, participation in committee or caucus sessions, and sightseeing in New York.
- A new student should be able to watch your video and understand what NMUN is about and why they might want to participate themselves.
- Be creative but keep in mind that decorum must be maintained; avoid the illegal use of copyrighted materials, videos containing profanity or other inappropriate content (this includes music lyrics) will be disqualified. YouTube has free music at: <https://www.youtube.com/audiolibrary/music>.
- Videos should be in English; anything recorded in another language should be subtitled.

**Judging:** NMUN staff will judge submitted videos and announce winners by 15 May 2017. Judging criteria will include quality, content, and creativity - make your video as fun and unique as possible!

**Prizes:** Two \$1,000 and two \$500 awards, applied toward delegate fees only, for NMUN•NY 2018.

**Note about conference filming:** Ultimately, the work of delegates and volunteer staff members in committee sessions is the highest priority during the conference. Camera operators should be courteous towards them and generally use caution and common sense when exiting, entering, filming, and moving around in committee rooms. Camera operators should respect all requests made by volunteer staff regarding distractions due to filming; failure to do so may result in disqualification from the contest.
